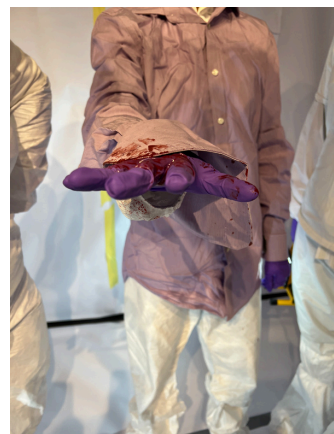
ADVANCED BPA TRAINING

16-20 MARCH 2026

40-HOUR COURSE / READING, UK

This week-long **non-residential** training course delivers theoretical and practical instruction in **ADVANCED BPA** and focusses on the application of BPA at crime scenes. The course is structured to allow participants, who have previously attended Level 2 (Basic) BPA Training (or a documented equivalent), to improve their skills and knowledge and attain competency in the independent analysis of bloodstain patterns at crime scenes and provide subsequent testimony as an expert witness. It is suitable for Forensic Scientists, Law Enforcement Personnel, Crime Scene Investigators, Laboratory Practitioners and other individuals aligned with BPA in the laboratory or at crime scenes as part of their ongoing professional development in BPA. It includes a session on gunshot-generated spatter, which is unique in the UK.

BASIC BPA TRAINING

14-18 SEPTEMBER 2026

40-HOUR COURSE / READING, UK

This week-long **non-residential** training course focusses on the **BASIC APPLICATION OF BPA**, and is suitable for Forensic Scientists, Law Enforcement Personnel, Crime Scene Investigators, Laboratory Practitioners and other individuals aligned with BPA in the laboratory or at crime scenes. The course uses classroom-based and practical (wet-blood) sessions, including simulated-assault scenarios, to provide participants with a knowledge base that will underpin the robust assessment of bloodstain patterns at crime scenes and on items examined in the laboratory. It meets the educational standards as defined by the IABPA and successful participants are able to apply for industry-standard professional membership.

This one-day **practical BPA** training course is particularly suited to crime scene professionals, forensic scientists, pathologists, medical personnel, police officers, judges, solicitors, barristers, academics and other interested parties. It is regularly delivered as part of the Crime Scene Investigation (Stage 1, Stage 2 or Crime Scene Manager) training programmes that now form a key part of practitioner training in the UK. This CPD training is designed to help participants develop an understanding of BPA and can assist them in the formulation of a forensic strategy, help with stain selection (for DNA analysis) and in identifying when a BPA analyst should be called in to assist in the investigation. Spaces on each day are limited and will be allocated on a first-booked basis.
